AGFUND IN BRIEF

The Arab Gulf Programme for Development (AGFUND) is a non-profit development organization, established in 1980 by the initiative of HRH Prince Talal Bin Abdul Aziz Al Saud and the support of the leaders of the Arab Gulf States (United Arab Emirates, Kingdom of Bahrain, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, State of Qatar, Sultanate of Oman and the State of Kuwait) that constitute its membership and contribute to its budget.

The key objective of AGFUND is to support human development efforts, including combating poverty, advancement of education, improvement of health standards, institutional development, training of workers of the civil society organizations and all development efforts targeting the neediest and disadvantaged groups in the developing countries, particularly women and children, without any discrimination as to sex creed or political affiliation.

Since its establishment AGFUND contributed to supporting and financing of 1472 projects in 133 countries in Asia, Africa, Latin America and Eastern Europe. 

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AGFUND INTERNATIONAL PRIZE FOR PIONEERING HUMAN DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

Idea of the Prize:

AGFUND International Prize for Pioneering Human Development Projects was established in 1999 by the Arab Gulf Programme for Development (AGFUND), with the aim of inciting and encouraging innovation and creativity in the areas of human development. The idea of the Prize was stemmed from AGFUND's approach to enhance development performance and support key development projects in order to achieve the goal of sustainability and investment in people.

In this sense, AGFUND Prize is considered to be the first initiative of its kind to identify successful development projects, reward them and disseminate their innovative ideas to best contribute to the improvement of development work. It is also an innovative approach and a strategic instrument to exchange successful experiences to strengthen the mechanisms of development cooperation and project funding with special emphasis on the most prominent factors that militate against development and affect the vulnerable groups, particularly women and children in developing countries. These include poverty, social exclusion, socio-economic marginalization, education and health.

Prize objectives:

AGFUND Prize aims to:

 Support the distinguished efforts aiming at the promotion and development of the concepts and dimensions of human development.

Disseminate the successful project experiences

 Highlight the best practices, which aim to improve the living conditions of the poor and disadvantaged with particular emphasis on women and children.

 Enhance the exchange of experiences and develop better mechanisms to find solutions to the problems of poverty, marginalization and socioeconomic exclusion of vulnerable groups

Prize categories:

AGFUND Prize is consisted of four categories:

First Category : Projects that are funded, designed and implemented by UN agencies or international and regional NGOs.

Second Category: Projects that are funded designed and implemented by national NGOs.

Third Category : Projects that are funded designed and implemented by government ministries and public agencies.

Fourth Category: Projects that are funded designed and implemented by individuals.

Prize awards:

The AGFUND Prize comprises:

 a. Cash amount of US\$ 500,000 (Five hundred thousand dollars) distributed as follows:

1. First category: US\$ 200,000 2. Second category: US\$ 150,000 3. Third category: US\$ 100,000

4. Fourth category: US\$ 50,000

b. Certificate of Recognition and trophics given to all winning projects in all categories.

Thematic focus:

Each year, the Prize Committee selects the thematic focus for the Prize, taking into account the diversification and non-

repetitive of themes. The objective is to highlight the innovative experiences and to continuously support the distinguished efforts in various field of development. The Prize themes always focus on the promotion of human knowledge in the field of human development and its proper management.

Nomination conditions:

- Nomination of a pioneering and sustainable project for the AGFUND International Prize constitutes a moral engagement between the Nominator and AGFUND
- The nominators shall not nominate their own projects, or projects in the implementation of which they have participated.
- Non-winning projects in a given year may not be resubmitted before three years from the date of their first submission.
- 4. For profit, projects shall not qualify for Prize.
- The nominator shall submit only brief information about the project as requested in SECTION ONE, which is assigned for nominators. Detailed information should be submitted by the implementing agency as requested in SECTION THREE.
- The nominator should be an agency or a qualified expert who is thoroughly aware of the project, in terms of design, objectives, target beneficiaries, funding, implementation and successful impact.
- Projects dealing with themes or topics other than the specified ones shall be disregarded.
- Nominations shall be made for projects that have already been completed or for ongoing projects a phase of which has been completed and evaluated.
- Nominations are submitted in two duplicates in any tanguage, provided that a validated translation into English of all documents is attached to the Nomination Form
- 10. For the Third category (assigned for projects by government ministries and public agencies), the eligible projects are those which have been conceived, designed, established, funded and implemented through pure national efforts, without participation of any international organizations or foreign governments.
- 11. All parts of the Nomination Form should be properly filled in by providing desired information and complying to the guidelines. In case the desired information are not available or irrelevant, it should be clearly indicated "not available or not applicable".) Hand written materials will not be accepted(.
- 12. The winners will be asked to sign a letter of Intent, prepared by AGFUND, on how to use the proceeds of the Prize, since the said Prize meant to finance the efforts aimed to support the expansion, sustainability and/or replication of the project.
- The documents required from the implementing agency in support of the nomination;

Please send the following together with the Nomination Form, bearing in mind that the documents submitted shall be more qualitative than quantitative:

- Feasibility Study (if applicable).
- Project document in full with annexes if any (including budget, work plan, implementation and Input, output, etc...)
- o Any amendments made to the project document

during implementation.

 Interim financial and physical reports prepared by the project implementation team.

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 Annual reports covering both financial and physical aspects and highlighting the constrains faced

 Monitoring and evaluation repots including impact evaluation.

Project final completion report.

 Any documents that highlight the activities of the project (photograph, video tapes, printed materials, CD).

- Two letters of recommendation from two different entities not related to the implementing entity and acceptable to AGFUND. Please note that each of the project's two Recommending entities should fill in the attached form (SECTION THREE).
- 14. The winning organizations shall confirm their participation in the award ceremony by their highest officials to receive the Prize:
 - The chairperson of the organization in the case of international organizations and NGOs.
 - The concerned minister in the case of government projects.
 - The founder of the project in the case of individual projects.

Evaluation process:

The nominated projects are evaluated by an International Team of Evaluators selected based on their international experience in development projects evaluation, their thorough knowledge of the theme of the Prize and indeed for their objectivity and fair assessment. The composition of this Team may vary from one year to another, depending on the thematic focus selected for each year.

Eligible nominations of all categories are evaluated in accordance with specific criteria dealing with the elements of creativity in the project, the efficiency and effectiveness of its management as well as the impact of the project. The evaluation shall be conducted based on the information provided in the Nomination Form, all documents sent in support of the nomination and on field visits to the project site if the need arises.

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Periodicity

The Prize shall be handed over to the heads of the winning organizations and the concerned ministers (in case of governments' projects), in an annual ceremony, to which representatives of the local and international development organizations located in the hosting country, development experts and specialists, diplomats, and media representatives are invited.

The Prize Committee:

The Prize is supervised by an international committee of renowned international personalities, who are selected based on their efforts and contributions to human development.
